1. ED Heart failure powerplan update

- Updated orders are to comply with the new accreditation standards.

Changes are below:

- remove Congestive out of title
- vitals 30min x2, then hourly
- remove insert foley
- add weight patient
- note added above diuretic initial IV dose Loop diuretic should be 1.5 to 2x oral daily dose
- Maintain oxygen saturation above 90% (was 95%)
- notify if SPO2 less than 90%, increase Dyspnea, chest pain and dizziness
- notify if fluids ordered greater than 500cc on acute CHF patients before infusing.

2. Remove Special instructions in Telemetry powerplan for Tylenol order.

On all of the telemetry orders, we have noticed that the Tylenol order is not compliant with Joint Commission standards. It contains more than one reason for prn use. We are removing Joint and muscular pain from the Special instructions field.
